Exchange Programme with the Middle East Technical University, Ankara, Turkey

We are now accepting applications for staff mobility (5 working days, 21-25 June 2021) at the Middle East Technical University (METU), Ankara, Turkey in their "International Virtual Staff Week". Staff Week will be online but **one** nominated staff who will be funded to be physically in Turkey will follow the program from there using this great opportunity. However, the travelling of our nominated staff member to METU will be considered with regard to the Covid-19 situation.

If more staff are interested in the program, you are more than welcome to apply as the training week will be held online.

The selection procedure will involve two application assessments, one at UNYT and another one at METU. The Committee strictly adheres to the principles of non-discrimination, equal access and opportunities to mobile participants working in the fields of international cooperation, student/staff mobility (e.g. International Officers, Staff Responsible for Summer Schools, International Recruitment, Strategic Planning, International Career Offices, Erasmus+ KA1, KA2 & KA3 projects) and/or support services offered for international students. Successful applicants will be expected to engage in training activity at METU.
