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

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
Composition and Selection of Members of the PCAQS

The Permanent Commission for Quality Standards Assurance is a collegial body, established at the institutional level, by the decision of the Academic Senate.

The Permanent Commission for Assurance of Quality Standards consists of no less than 5 (five) members and no more than 7 (seven) members. One of the members of the PCAQS is a student representative.

The members of the Commission are self-nominated and elected by the Academic Senate. They have a two-year mandate, with the right to re-election. The commission elects the chairman from among its members.

Quality Assurance Unit (QAU)

Quality Assurance Unit is an independent body established at the institutional level by the Academic Senate's decision.

Student Evaluation Process

At the University of New York in Tirana (UNYT), the student evaluation process is conducted twice a year for academic staff with ongoing teaching responsibilities and twice per semester for faculty members who are teaching for the first time.

This evaluative framework is systematically designed to assess the effectiveness of academic programs, the quality of instruction, and the overall student experience.

The process is integral to ensuring that educational standards are consistently upheld and that continuous improvements are made based on student feedback.

Here is a detailed outline of the procedural framework as it is executed throughout the academic year:

























STUDENT COURSE EVALUATION
